STX Animal Welfare Center Launches New Program

The St. Croix Animal Welfare Center is launching a new program, Project SAFE, to help keep pets healthy, happy, and at home with the people who love them. This program was recently funded by the ASPCA. We will be conducting pop-up clinics once per month throughout the island. These low-cost pop up clinics and the other supports available through the program are designed to reduce barriers and increase access to care for members of our community, ultimately helping people keep and care for the pets they love. We know that there are so many animal lovers in our community, and also how many families are struggling to make ends meet and we are here to help.

Can you help us spread the word about this pop up clinic in downtown Frederiksted? It will be this Saturday, April 20th from 9-12. We can see people's pet dogs and cats. This clinic is primarily for the residents of the Frederiksted area but others will be scheduled elsewhere throughout the year. Details are on the flyers attached in both English and Spanish. FREE veterinary exam. \$5 vaccines, \$5 deworming, \$5 flea/tick treatment, \$5 microchipping, \$5 heartworm testing. FREE spay/neuter vouchers. Plus, the first 50 people who bring their pets for care on Saturday will get a free 32 lb bag of dog food! If transportation to the venue is an issue for a resident living in or around the Frederiksted area, we can help with transportation if coordinated in advance.
